- -A member of the Shade Tree Commission will visit your address and determine the proper tree for your location based on several factors including; Presence of planting strip, wires overhead/no wires overhead etc.
- -Locations with wires overhead will receive Ornamental Trees (flowering trees that don't reach a height over 25 feet).
- -Locations without overhead wires will receive a Shade Tree that will eventually reach a height of 50-60 feet.
- -Resident's only responsibility would be to help the young tree with watering if needed.
- -Planting would occur each fall.
- -Trees will be planted on a first come basis
- -The number of trees planted each fall will depend upon funds available to the Shade Tree Commission at that time.
- -Every resident who applies for a free tree will get one at some point.
- -When we get closer to the planting date the STC will email and inform you of the approximate planting date. The STC will also order a utility mark out (no-charge).
- -Trees will be 2.5" Caliper at time of planting (Shade Trees 10-12 Feet, Ornamental 8-10 Feet)
- -Tree Species will be selected by STC. Only deep-rooted trees will be utilized to avoid sidewalk damage.
