# Welcome to the Monmouth County Library



With a Monmouth County Library card you can borrow books, videos, DVDs, CDs, circulating magazines, audiobooks and more! You can download eBooks, the latest magazines, take computer courses and make use of our many online research databases.

Your library card can be used at any of our 13 library branches. Branch libraries are located across the County. Library materials taken out at one location may be returned to another branch.

Library cards are free if you live or own property in one of our contributing member municipalities, you can just show your driver's license (or another ID that has your street address) at any of our branches and you will be given a free three-year library card. A parent or legal guardian must be present to register children under 17 for a youth card.

Some towns are not eligible for a free library card.

### How your card works

#### How long can I keep the items I borrow?

- For books, audiobooks, CDs and circulating magazines 2 weeks
- For Lucky Day best sellers 1 week (no renewals)
- Entertainment DVDs 2 days
- TV Series DVDs 1 week
- Instructional DVDs 1 week
- eBooks from Library on the Go! 7 to 14 days

#### How do I renew my items?

- Items can be renewed three times if no one is waiting for the item.
- Items can be renewed online, using our mobile app, over the phone and in person.

#### How do I place a request for an item?

- You can place a request in person, on the phone to any branch library, online or using the library's mobile app.
- Patrons are notified by phone when an item they requested is available.

#### How do I download eBooks?

- eBooks and audiobooks can be downloaded from the library's own *Library on the Go!* with more than 27,000 titles.
- You can also place holds on titles. eBooks can be checked out for 7 or 14 days, and can be renewed if it is available.
- You can always ask the staff for assistance with downloading books.

#### What are the late fees?

- For adult books, audiobooks, CDs, magazines 10 cents per day, \$4 maximum per item.
- For children's books, audiobooks, CDs, magazines 10 cents per day, \$2 maximum per item.
- Videos, DVDs \$1 per day, \$10 maximum per item.
- Borrower will be charged the replacement cost of a lost item.

# How do I replace a lost Library Card?

■ Please report a lost or stolen library card as soon as possible. Lost library cards can be replaced for a \$1 fee.

# How do I renew my Library Card?

■ Your library card expires after three years. To renew, simply bring your driver's license or other ID with your address to a branch library and your card will be renewed.

#### Special collections

Our Eastern Branch in Shrewsbury is the place for Federal, NJ State and Monmouth County documents. Our Headquarters in Manalapan includes the Monmouth County Historical Room where you can find a variety of materials about state, county, and local history. Patrons can research current and historical information about Monmouth County and New Jersey including businesses, institutions, agriculture, economics, government documents, biographical and genealogical information and more.

#### Children's Service and Programs

Every library has children's story times most weeks. Most branches host special crafts ,events and research help for children up to Grade 5 and . Every summer, there are programs and prizes for summer reading. Programs can be found by clicking the Children's link at the top of our webpage.
