Crossing Guard Positions Available

Crossing guards are deployed in the morning and at the end of the school day.

Requirements

- Applicants must not have a conviction for any criminal offense.
- There are no formal education or experience requirements for this job, but all candidates must be able to understand English and speak English well enough to be understood.
- Prior to appointment, prospective candidates must pass a qualifying medical examination and a character/background investigation.
- Once appointed, candidates must complete two hours of classroom instruction and twenty hours of field training under the supervision of an experienced crossing guard.
