REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES

The Borough of Manasquan is soliciting Professional Engineering Services Proposals from qualified firms, or groups of firms, to provide **construction inspection and contract administration** (CA/CI) of the Business District Streetscape Improvement Project about the intersection of Taylor Avenue (State Highway 71) and Main Street in the Borough of Manasquan. The construction consists of traffic signal, roadway, pedestrian, and landscaping improvements. The scope of services to be provided consists of construction oversight and documentation of said construction project. Daily inspection reports, material testing, wage rate reviews, material certifications and other required documentation are to be provided by the Consultant along with preparing as-built construction plans. RFP responses must be made on the standard proposal forms, must be enclosed in a sealed package organized into two (2) parts (labeled “**Technical Proposal**” and “**Cost Proposal**”, respectively) and bearing the name and address of the prime consultant and the RFP Title Name and Contract Number of the outside of the envelope. This package shall be addressed to the Borough of Manasquan, Attn.: Municipal Clerk, 201 East Main Street, Manasquan, New Jersey 08736.

The selection process that will be utilized is a Qualifications Based Selection Process in accordance with the Federal Brooks Act. Each technical proposal received by the stipulated cut-off date and which meets the prequalification requirements stipulated herein will be evaluated by a consultant selection committee.

Proposals are being solicited through a fair and open process in accordance with N.J.S.A 19:44A-20.2, et. seq., and as such contractors are exempt from the limitations on making political contributions under that law. Further, for that reason, as well as because of language in New Jersey’s Annual Appropriations Act, refusal to disclose campaign contributions otherwise required by N.J.S.A 19:44A-20.2 et. seq. will not adversely affect your consideration for award.

Sealed Proposals will be received up to 4 : 0 0 P M on April 18, 2024.
