## **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

Administration and Finance Committee – Council Member Mangan reported on Provident Bank Lease, expansion of e-mail capabilities, updates for the website, and he reported that the budget will hopefully be introduced later this month. He reported that he is looking into the Community Disaster Loan (CDL) closeout and that the committee is staying on top of this and that the Borough needs to make an official request for the closeout. He advised that the committee will be meeting to go over the budget.

Special Services Committee - Council Member Read advised that he has nothing to report at this time.

Public Safety – Council Member Olivera thanked council for approving the safety ordinances tonight. He reported that the police department participated in operation "Take Back" which is where residents are able to turn in any expired or unwanted medication and he thanked all the residents that participated. He reported that the police department wants to warn residents of recent car burglaries and to lock their cars and if anyone sees anything suspicious they should notify the police department. He reported that the police department has received numerous complaints relating to dogs on the beach and walkway which borough ordinance restricts at certain times of the year.

Beach Committee – Council Member McCarthy reported that it is 25 days before the beach opens with Memorial Day right around the corner. He reported on the beach badge sale days and he reported that the beach is starting to look good getting ready for the season. He thanked the Chief for the notice that went into the Coast Star regarding dogs on the beach and he reported on the beach bathroom schedule. He reported on the fireworks that tourism has scheduled for Memorial Day Weekend. He thanked Leggetts and Manasquan Bank and he stated that there is a cocktail party scheduled for May 26 at Leggetts with beach badges being given away.

Building, Planning & Zoning – Council Member Walsh reported on a meeting the Code Department had with the realtors to go over the basic protocol of certificate of occupancy. He reported that the realtors reported a dramatic decrease in the use of realtors for their service. He reported that the Supervising Code Enforcement Officer has narrowed down the potential software program choice.

Public Works & Grounds – Council Member Lee thanked the committee members for their input on the Life Saving Station use agreement renewal. He reported that the Preservation Committee has asked permission to hire an outside architect for the gutters and leaders of which they would be willing to cover the consulting fee of \$9,800 and they would also pay up to \$30,000 towards the cost of construction. He reported that the committee recommends this approach. He requested a resolution be on the next meeting detailing that the architect fees will not exceed \$9,800 and that the preservation committee will pay the \$30,000 towards the gutters and leaders and that all decisions on the building come back to council for their approval. He stated that the committee is making a recommendation for a new full time hire in the roads department as a laborer due to a retirement and they recommend Ryan Shinn which a resolution to this affect will be on the next agenda.

There was a discussion on the summer help and Ryan Shinn moving up from that position.

It was recommended that Tom Nicastro move forward with interviewing for an additional summer hire as Mr. Shinn will come off the summer list to a full time employee.

Council Member Lee reported that May 15 will be Parks Day and an announcement will go out.

Mayor Donovan congratulated the Environmental Commission on the paper shredding event and the beach sweep event.

### AUDIENCE PARTICIPATION

Council Member Olivera made a motion to open the meeting to the public, seconded by Council Member Read. Motion carried unanimously.

Mary Ryan, 113 Beachfront commented on the shredding event, beach sweep, dogs on the beach and walkway, and the town wide garage sale and the clean up afterwards.

Gina Pharo, Perrine Blvd. requested help with a sewer problem that she had at 101 First Avenue and some type of report from the engineer. She went over the events of the problem.

There was discussion on the issue and Mr. Nolan state he would get her address and relay the message to Jim Priolo from Maser Consulting.

Council Member Walsh made a motion to close the public portion, seconded by Council Member McCarthy.
