

MARCH 19, 2012

A Work Session Meeting of Mayor and Council was convened at 7:00 p.m. on March 19, 2012 in Council Chambers of Borough Hall with Mayor Dempsey presiding.

Mayor Dempsey related that this meeting is being held in accordance with the Open Public Meetings Act of 1975 and that notice was given to the Coast Star and the Asbury Park Press on December 7, 2011.

STATUS REPORT: Charles Rooney, Borough Engineer Report

Mr. Charles Rooney read the Engineer's report dated March 16, 2012.

ITEM #1 Use of Borough Property

Council Member Bossone made a motion to approve this request, seconded by Council Member Mangan. Motion carried unanimously.

ITEM #2 Dog's on the Beach - Discussion

Council Member McCarthy stated that he had a meeting with the Public Safety Committee along with the Administrator and the Police Chief to discuss dogs on the beach. He advised that the Police Chief has assured that there will be one officer at the beach every half hour to hour looking for dogs on the beach. He stated that there have

been many complaints raised to various elected officials. He stated that the enforcement does become easier on April 1 because leashed dogs are prohibited from the entire beach front area. He went over the time frame that leashed dogs are allowed on the beach only and never allowed on the walkway at any time. He went over the research as to who can write tickets for dogs on the beach.

Mr. DeIorio recommended that the council consider banning dogs completely from the beach front area and that would alleviate having the problem of when they are allowed and not allowed.

Council Member McCarthy stated that this is a law that needs to be enforced and some people will not be happy with the results of the tickets but it needs to start happening now.
