

JULY 6, 2015

A Work Session Meeting of Mayor and Council was convened at 7:00 p.m. on July 6, 2015 in Council Chambers of Borough Hall with Mayor Dempsey presiding.

Mayor Dempsey's statement re: Open Public Meetings Act of 1975 and that notice was given to the Coast Star and the Asbury Park Press on December 18, 2014 and January 5, 2015.

Also present was Borough Engineer Rob DeCotiis, Borough Attorney Mark Kitrick and Borough Administrator/CFO Joseph DeIorio.

ITEM #1: Use of Borough Property

- MHS Swim Team – One Mile Swim – July 19, 2015 Elks Beach

Council Member Donovan made a motion to approve this request, seconded by Council Member McCarthy. Motion carried unanimously.

- Squan Strong – Neon Run – October 17, 2015 – Beach Area

There was discussion on this event with a representative from Squan Strong.

Council Member Sinneck made a motion to approve this request with the condition that the run stay on the boardwalk to avoid fees charged to the organization for traffic control, seconded by Council Member Lee. Motion carried unanimously.

- Manasquan Bank Fair – October 24, 2015 – Squan Plaza

Council Member Donovan made a motion to approve this request, seconded by Council Member McCarthy. Motion carried unanimously.

- Tandem Cycle, LLC – July 25, 2015 – Inlet Gazebo/Boardwalk

There was discussion on this event as to where and when and what time the request is for with the owners of Tandem Cycle. It was suggested that the event be held after Labor Day.

It was suggested that the event date be changed until after Labor and Tandem Cycle bring back a new date to council for approval.

Council Member McCarthy made a motion to approve this request with the condition that all equipment will be off Borough Property by dusk, seconded by Council Member Mangan. Motion carried unanimously.

Council Member Donovan requested that a request from the Manasquan River Veterans Offshore Grand Prix to have a vendor to sell custard at the western end of the Inlet on the grassy area with the proceeds going to veteran causes be added to the agenda.

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Council Member Sinneck made a motion to approve this request, seconded by Council Member McCarthy. Motion carried unanimously.

Council Member Olivera inquired about the DEP Green Acres Grant for Mallard Park, the low interest loan.
