The Borough of Manasquan is pleased to announce that it is starting the repaying Euclid Avenue from Route 71 to Mount Lane and Mount Lane from Euclid Avenue to Marcellus Avenue. The following information applies, all weather depending:

- 1. Hydrant replacement will take place on March 9th, 2023. This may have impacts on traffic.
- 2. Stormwater Improvements and Concrete work will start fully on March 15th, 2023. The duration of the project is expected to be approximately 45 days.
- 3. The project will be paused when pipe work is completed for trench settling and concrete work is complete.
- 4. No work will be performed on weekends or Borough Holidays.
- 5. Mount Lane and Euclid Avenue will periodically be blocked to thru traffic in sections during the work day.
- 6. Mount Lane and Euclid Avenue will remain open during non-work hours.
- 7. Utility work inclusive of Fire Hydrant Improvements staring March 9, 2023 and should be completed by March 10th.
- 8. Concrete and inclusive of ADA compliant ramp upgrades will commence after the Residents are to be aware and adhere to no parking signage posted in the area of construction.
 - 9. Milling and paving work will follow concrete work and trench settlement time. A separate notice will be sent regarding these activities.
 - 10. Staging and work will commence no earlier than 7am.
