Dear Residents,

It has been an honor to serve as your Mayor since January, and I have been busy working with the Council on your behalf. We have some exciting plans for the year that I would like to share with you.

The first major area of focus is on increasing communication from the borough and developing ways to involve more people in the process and decisions that are made in town. We will be reinstating the quarterly borough newsletter, both in electronic form and printed and mailed to each home. We have been and will continue to revamp the borough website to make it more user friendly. We are developing a Manasquan APP, for residents and visitors to centralize and simplify information and to allow a greater back and forth between Borough Hall and the residents. We will also be revamping the meeting broadcast system for both Borough Council and Planning Board to ensure maximum transparency and citizen involvement.

We have also expanded citizen roles in volunteer groups throughout the Borough. I am proud to see the creation of the new Mayor's Charity Ball Committee, the expansion of the Recreation Committee, the reorganization of the Open Space Committee, the continued success of the Shade Tree, Environmental and Tourism Commissions, as well as the expanded Citizen's Advisory Committee including Beautification SubGroup and the Holiday Decorating SubGroup. These dedicated volunteers are the backbone of our community – they serve quietly and strongly to make sure that Manasquan stays the great small town we all love.

The second major area of focus is on stopping overdevelopment and limiting density. To that end, I have created the Mayors Commission on Zoning, which is made up of members of the Borough Council, Planning Board, and the public. This Commission has already begun its work by starting the process of collecting and sorting the date needed for a proper zoning review. This will be a public process – and a slow one – by design to ensure maximum citizen input before any changes are made. Stay tuned for updates in the coming months.

As other issues arise, I am confident that, working with the Borough Council, Manasquan's town government will continue to be open and accessible, now more

than ever. Please do not hesitate to reach out to myself or any member of the Borough Council at any time with any questions, comments or concerns. More exciting things coming soon!

If trash is not picked up, please report it to the Police Dispatcher at 732-223-1000.

Inspections for the summer rental season will begin in April. As a reminder, all applications must be submitted online and will not be processed or scheduled until payment is received. Inspections are done Monday through Thursday between 9am and 12pm. Code Enforcement will be out every weekend beginning Memorial Day. Some things to keep in mind:

- No parking outside driveway areas, on lawn or blocking an emergency exit or access route.
- Please make sure your trash and recycling is out on the correct day of pickup; place trash out the night prior or by 6am on your scheduled trash day, and remove empty containers prior to 8am the following morning.
- Bulk pick-up items can only be placed curbside on your FIRST weekday garbage collection and must be limited to ONE item. There is NO bulk pickup in June, July and August.
- Special Bulk Pickup will be May 20th-24th. A Max of 5 bulk items will be picked up.

**Please be aware that new legislation has been passed regarding Lead-Based paint in rental dwellings. The new law (P.L.2021, c.182) imposes an obligation on municipalities to perform inspections of certain single-family, two-family, and multiple rental dwellings for lead-based paint hazards. More information will follow.

Hurricane Season is Approaching



Hurricane season begins June 1st and runs thru November 30th, peaking in mid-September. Now is the time to conduct an insurance check-up and make sure that you have plans in place should Manasquan be threatened by a tropical system.

Manasquan participates in the National Flood Insurance Program, which makes flood insurance available to everyone. Residents automatically receive a 25% reduction in annual flood insurance premiums as a result of our participation in the Community Rating System. We strongly urge you to consider buying flood insurance if you don't have it already!
